## General Membership Meeting

#### Race Directors

**Temple Canyon:** No Report.

**Monarch:** Ted does not have the permit in hand, however he has been verbally assured by the Forest Service that we will have it in time for our race. We will proceed with our certificate of insurance and Ted will provide Trudy with the named insured. There will be no pitting at the bottom area. Please bring your trash to the lodge and throw in the trash truck. There are also camp sites available at the Monarch Spur Campground. We are still in need of ticket takers for this race.

**Core:** Ted reported that the Core race went well. We did have a very low turn out. Discussion was heard on returning to Core in September. Rod will compose a letter requesting participation at Core and the letter will be posted on the CHCA website. We will discuss returning or not at driver's meeting at Core.

#### Race Officials

**Chief Steward:** Mike will be out of town on the dates of the Core race. Ron Burge will serve as acting Chief Steward for the Monarch race.

**Safety:** Bob reported that all is in order for Monarch.

**Tech:** Ron has had a request to do engine pumping. Ron has been unable to get the pump from Gene Pacheco as Gene is concerned about letting it go as Gene is concerned that it might get broken. Rod will take care of getting the pump to Ron.

**Timing:** We are in great need of timers for Monarch. Janet Marcovich will serve as timing director at Monarch.

**Scales:** Ron is requesting engine sizes on all race vehicles. It was decided that all Super Sprints need to post their minimum weight on their vehicle. Rodney Omaley will contact all Super Sprint
